ARTICLE 2. On a motion the Town Of Appleton voted to authorize the Selectmen to issue bonds and other evidence of indebtedness in the name of the Town for small scale school construction and renovation purposes in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Dollars (\$531,000) to do renovations and construct a small scale addition to the Appleton Village School located on the existing school lot on the westerly side of Union Road in the Town of Appleton. These renovations include replacing the school roof and gymnasium floor. A secret ballot was ordered for this vote. The results were 47 in favor and 28 opposed.

Application for State and any other aid available, for this project, shall be applied for, by the school board, at the request of the Town.

A motion to adjourn was made and seconded at 8:25pm.
